



- ❖ **Hop Variety:** ***Brewers Gold***
- ❖ **Origin:** A open pollinated cross of a Manitoban wild hop (BB1) originating in England
- ❖ **Maturity:** Late
- ❖ **Yield:** 2100 – 2400 kgs/ha
- ❖ **Disease Reaction:** Low resistance to wilt; very low resistance to downy mildew and low resistance to powdery mildew
- ❖ **Cone Structure:** Medium size, oval
- ❖ **Quality:**
- **Aroma** Strong, blackcurrant
