



- ❖ **Hop Variety:** ***Pride of Ringwood***
- ❖ **Origin:** Bred in Australia from an English variety – Pride of Kent; released in 1965.
- ❖ **Maturity:** Mid-late season
- ❖ **Yield:** 2200 - 2800 kgs/ha (1940-2469 lbs/acre)
- ❖ **Disease Reaction:** As downy and powdery mildew are not found in Australia resistance is not defined
- ❖ **Cone Structure:** Fairly long, tight cone
- ❖ **Quality:**
- **Aroma** Pronounced but pleasant
 - **Storage Stability** Average-Good
- ❖ **HPLC Data:**
- **Alpha-Acids** 7.0 – 10.0% w/w
 - **Cohumulone** 33 - 39% of alpha-acids
